



2019-2020 ImPact Concussion Management Program Consent Form

For the 2019-2020 school year, it is mandatory for ALL student-athletes participating in the sports below to complete the ImPact Concussion baseline test before regular season tryouts begin. These specific sports were identified as “higher-risk sports” after consulting with the physicians, neuropsychologists and other experts in the field.

The importance of the baseline test is that it measures various aspects of your child’s neurocognitive function including memory, attention span, brain process speed, reaction time, and post-concussion symptoms. The baseline testing is an evaluation of how your child’s brain is functioning under normal conditions and is used for comparison in post-concussion testing if a concussion is sustained. The ImPact is not a stand-alone tool to diagnose concussion, it is not a cure for concussions, and does not substitute for medical evaluation and treatment. ImPact is a computerized test that consists of 6 modules that measure the neurocognitive function. The test takes approximately 30 minutes to complete.
