

2015 Scholarships

In support of our local communities and patrons, Ag Link Incorporated will sponsor nine \$750 scholarships. One scholarship will be awarded to a qualified graduating senior from Almira-Coulee-Hartline, Christian Heritage, Creston, Davenport, Dayton, Reardan and Wilbur High Schools.* Two additional open scholarships will be awarded as designated below.

Each applicant, or his/her immediate family, must be an Ag Link patron.**

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academics, activities, citizenship, and a short essay. Where possible, Ag Link Inc. will join with local Dollars-for-Scholars groups to award scholarships. The Dollars for Scholars ranking system is used as part of the selection criteria.

The information given should represent you as completely as possible, not only as a student, but also as a well-rounded individual. Complete the form carefully and address all the questions asked in the essay.

East Area (5): Christian Heritage, Dayton, Davenport and Reardan + one additional open scholarship for other public school districts serviced by Ag Link including Harrington and Sprague.

- 1. Christian Heritage, Harrington, Reardan, and Sprague: Applicants must submit this application and the supporting materials to Ag Link Inc., Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 77, Reardan, WA 99029. All completed applications must be postmarked or delivered to the Reardan office during business hours no later than April 25, 2015.
- 2. Davenport High School: Applicants must submit this application and the supporting materials to Ag Link Inc., Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 77, Reardan, WA 99029. All completed applications must be postmarked or delivered to the Reardan office during business hours no later than April 25, 2015.
- 3. Dayton High School: Applicants must submit this application and the supporting materials to Ag Link Inc., Scholarship Committee, 108 N. Pine, Dayton, WA 99328 no later than April 25, 2015.
- 4. High school seniors who live within these public school district boundaries, but attend another high school, may qualify to apply for an open scholarship if their family purchases products from Ag Link such as delivered fuel and/or chemicals. Students should check with the Ag Link office in Reardan. The deadline to submit this application and supporting materials to the Reardan corporate office is April 25, 2015.

West Area (4): Almira-Coulee-Hartline, Creston and Wilbur + one additional scholarship will be awarded from the pool of applications received - Application and supporting materials must be postmarked or delivered by April 26, 2015, to Ag Link Inc., Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 177, Almira, WA 99103.

- 4. (max 40 pts) Attach a 1.5 line spaced typed essay of approx. 300 words that responds to the following 3 questions:
 - a. How is agriculture important to our local economy?
 - b. What are your future goals and how have you begun to work toward one or more of your goals?
 - c. What is your post-high school educational plan? How does your plan fit into your goals?
- If no qualified applicant applies from one of the listed high schools, an additional recipient may be selected from one of the other area schools. ** Examples of Ag Link Inc. patronage include purchasing food or fuel from Traders Express in Davenport, items from the Reardan Hardware store, or products from Ag Link Inc. The latter is required for students applying for any open scholarship.
